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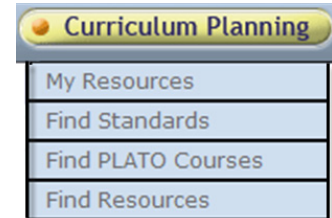
■ Reviewing the Prescription

The result is that learners can receive assignments that focus on just their individual needs.

About the Assessment

1. Select *Find Resources*.
2. **Define your search criteria** by Keyword, Grade Range, and Subject. For Type, select Assessment.
3. Select *View Details* from your selected Assessment  menu.





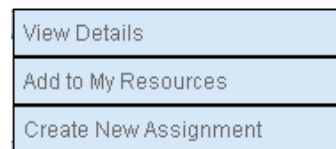

Considerations

- Both Administrators and Teachers can assign Assessments. Teachers can assign only to their own classes; however, Administrators can assign them to any populated class within their permissions.
- Administer pre-, mid-, and post tests to monitor learner progress throughout the school year.

Assigning the Assessment

1. Access *Find Resources* from the *Curriculum Planning* tab.
2. **Define your search criteria** by Keyword, Grade Range, and Subject.
For Type, select Assessment.
3. **Locate the Assessment** you want to assign.
4. Select, from , either *Add to My Resources* for future lesson planning or *Create New Assignment* directly.
5. **Identify Learners** to receive the assignment. Assessments are assigned by Class.
 - Assign to a single class.
 - Assign to multiple classes by using the “All Classes” default. Deselect any classes you wish to remove from receiving the assignment.
 - Remove individual learner assignments by navigating to *My Classroom* under *Class Administration*. From , select *Add/Remove Learners* for that Assessment assignment.
6. Select “Yes/No” in the field for the **Auto-Assign Prescription** field.
 - “Yes” will result in an automatic assignment of the prescribed learning path.
 - “No” will allow you to view, edit, and assign the prescription at your discretion.
7. **Choose a date range** to define the period of time that the Assessment may be taken.



Taking the Assessment	Viewing the Prescription before Assignment
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Learners see the Assessment as an assignment. ■ Save options allow each student to leave the Assessment at any time and continue later. All the data to that point will be saved. ■ Tests are scored, and results can be viewed once learners click the Grade Test option. ■ When the Assessment is complete, it will disappear from the list of assignments. ■ An individual prescription to instruction will appear as an assignment: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. automatically if “Yes” option was selected under Auto-Assign Prescription 2. upon review and edit from the Teacher if “No” option was selected ■ Manage the assessment assignment under <i>Classroom Administration</i>. 	 <p>View the details of the prescribed instruction for each learner upon completion of the Assessment assignment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Access <i>My Classroom</i> under <i>Classroom Administration</i>. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select modules to assign, all or any. 5. Note that a new assignment is created with the prescription for the learner. 6. Note the actual test items that the learner answered incorrectly. ■ Manage the prescription assignment under <i>Classroom Administration</i>.

Helpful Hint

Learners inherit the Start and End dates set when the Assessment was initially assigned. Consider narrowing the assignment dates for individual learners based on schedules or other factors.
