



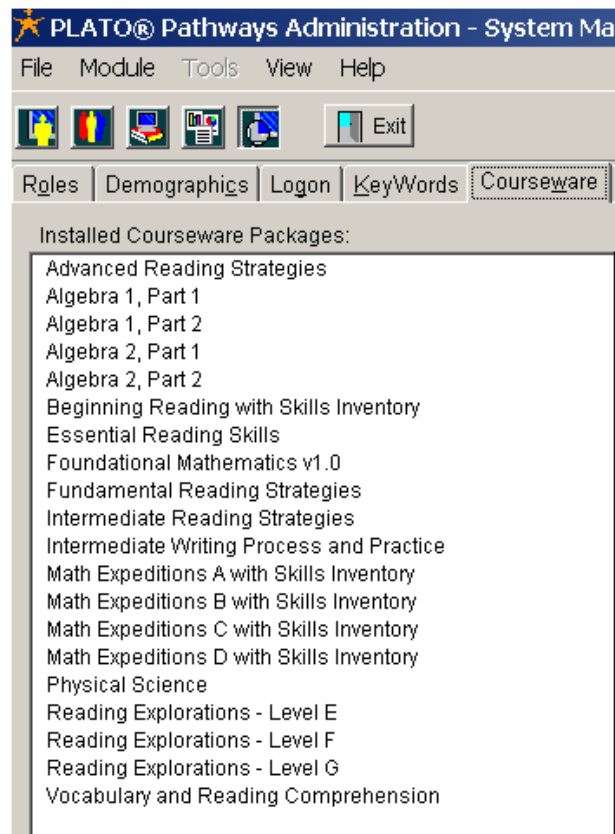
**Pathways Courseware Updater
v1.2 Instructions**

Who should run this update?

Run this update if you have any of the following courseware installed on a network system or on a hard drive in a standalone workstation.



The update is safe to run even if you don't know what courseware or what version of courseware is currently installed. This update will only be applied to courseware that has been installed but is out of date. You may rerun the updater if current courseware is reinstalled or new courseware is installed to make sure any relevant updates are applied.



Running The Updater

It's recommended that Administrators and Learners log out of Pathways, but that is not an enforced requirement. The updater can be run from any workstation connected to a Pathways network system to update the entire Pathways system. For standalone workstations the updater must be run on each workstation.

Windows XP and older workstations: Double click on the Pathways_Courseware_Updater_v1.2.exe file. Follow the on-screen instructions. The updated software is installed to a temporary location on the workstation's hard drive and will begin automatically. When the update has finished installing, the updater files are automatically deleted.

Windows Vista workstations: Insert the Pathways Courseware Updater CD into the disc drive. Double click on the Pathways_Courseware_Updater_v1.2.exe file. Follow the on-screen instructions. The updater software installs to a folder on the workstation's hard drive and an icon appears on the desktop. The install will close automatically. Double-click the desktop icon labeled "Pathways Courseware Updater v1.2". The updater automatically closes when it has completed the update.

You can uninstall the updater files just as you would any other software. Open the Windows Control Panel Home link on the left, and then click on the "Uninstall a program" link. In the list of programs, double-click on Pathways_Courseware_Updater_v1.2 and click the Uninstall/Change button.

Updater Log File: A log is created in the PWAY\INSTLOG folder. The file name for the log is "ResRev_yyyymmdd.Log" where yyyy is the year, mm is the month, and dd is the day. Example: ResRev_20080604.Log. Subsequent runs done on the same day append to the end of the log file.

A normal run produces a list of the courseware titles and resources that have been updated such as follows:

If there's no courseware that needs updating the log would look similar to the list below:

If the installed courseware is not the current version, the log contains entries similar to the list below:
